The principal aims and objectives of the group, which is a wholly voluntary based community initiative include:

"Fostering the understanding of local, national and global environmental sustainability - and thereby seeking to achieve sustainable environmental improvements locally with the ultimate purpose of creating a carbon neutral area."

Then these could be described as our Objectives in achieving these aims:-
